- Trades Training programs targeted to be open for full admission and start up in September, 2010

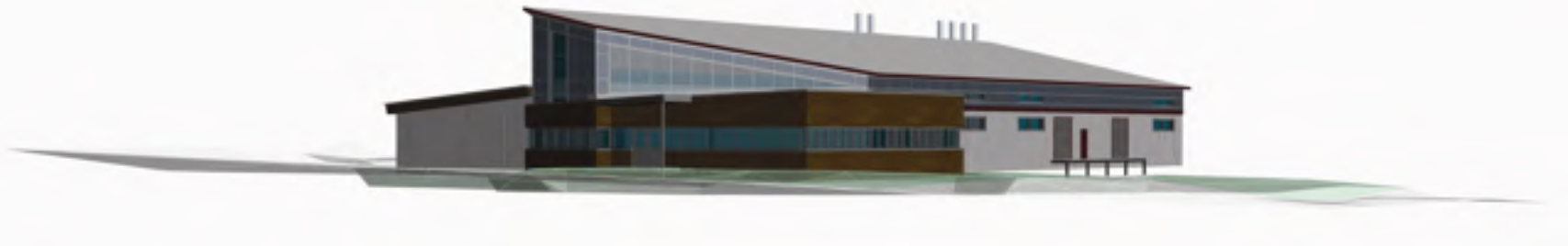


Exterior Elevations - NTTC

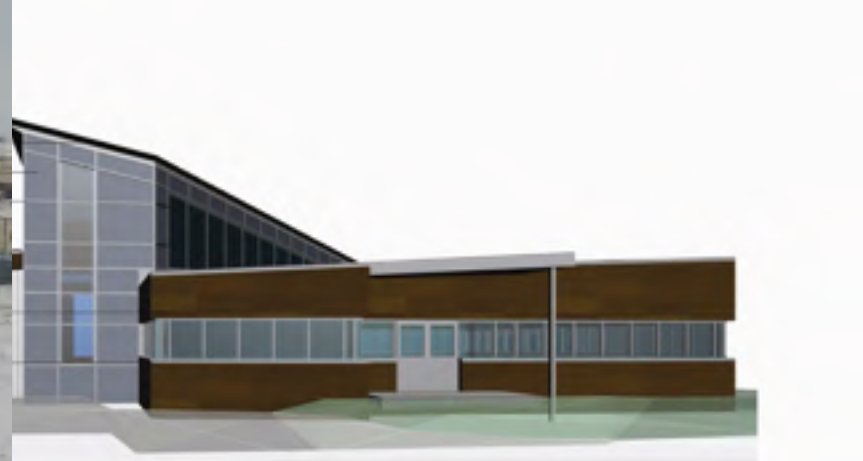

Programming Structure

- Rankin Inlet is the primary location for trades administration and programming support.
 - Cambridge Bay is slated for programs in the mining sector with a new mine training facility.
 - Iqaluit will maintain all 4 levels of Carpentry programs and Housing Maintainer 3rd year.
 - Kivalliq Campus will continue to support the CARS program delivery for Nunavut.
-

Current Activities

- **Meetings with Department of Education**
 - Discuss trades applications and accreditation process.
 - **Meetings with Nunavut Mine Training Roundtable**
 - Creation of the Kivalliq Mine Training Society.
 - **Completing Pre-trades for Nunavut Housing Trust**
 - 40 Pre-trades programs delivered over 4 years.
 - **Planning Meetings in Cambridge Bay– Mine Training**
 - \$1.1M is budgeted for Architectural & Engineering
 - Construction estimate to be table for GN's fall sitting.

Planned Activities

- **Receive Inventory and set up New Trades School**
 - \$1.25M budget for Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment.
 - **Working with Nunavut Housing Corporation**
 - Advancement of training opportunities with NHC.
 - **Developing Heavy Equipment Programs - OETIO.**
 - Meeting this spring to look at transfer of curriculum.
 - Still targeting Heavy Equipment Operator, Heavy Duty Equipment Technician, Automotive Technician for Phase 2 by 2012-14

Mine Training for Cambridge Bay

- Original plan is to deliver Apprenticeship Program in Millwright Levels One and Two and Welding Levels One and Two in the centre
 - Need to consult regionally/ industry/ establish advisory group
 - FANS eligible programs should be
 - Certificate Program in Millwright 160 days
 - Trades Access Certificate 160 days
 - Mine Industry Trades Access Program 160 days
